

Report Testing on Offspring

Dries 421

December 21, 2009

Exterior

General

The offspring of Dries 421 are a uniform group of breed typical horses that in conformation could have a bit more length in the legs. The horses stand out positively with their length in stride and suppleness in movement and good use of the hind legs. The inspected offspring of Dries 421 are out of somewhat above average quality mares (ster % of dams: 71%). The number of inspected horses is above average (64% of the registered mares was inspected).

Breed type:

The Dries 421 offspring are breed typical horses with nicely shaped heads. The necks have sufficient length and are more than sufficiently vertical. The horses are of a jetblack color and have much hair.

Conformation:

The offspring of Dries 421 are somewhat short-legged horses that in spite of that are sufficiently uphill in conformation. The hses are often a bit weak in the upper line. The croups are long and correct in slope.

Legs:

The hind legs are often a bit sickle hocked and a number of offspring could be drier in the hock joint.

Movement in hand:

The offspring of Dries 421 have much length in stride in movement in which the use of the hind legs stands out. The horse also show much suppleness.

Performance:

General

18 offspring of Dries 421 completed the ABFP test.

Walk

The walk has more than sufficient length in stride and is active in the hind legs. The front legs could be placed a bit further forward.

Trot

The trot has length in stride, is powerful, and has self carriage. The horses also show much suppleness and have more than sufficient balance.

Canter

The canter has more than sufficient length in stride and is sufficiently uphill. The horses show self carriage and good balance in canter.

Suitability as riding horses

The offspring of Dries 421 under saddle have three good basic gaits. In addition they are easy to work with with a good attitude. The horses have much suppleness with a good ability to transition in the gaits. A number of offspring somewhat lack the ability to lengthen in the neck. The Dries 421 offspring have good talent as riding horses.

Suitability as show-driving horses

The Dries 421 offspring stand out in harness with their good use of the hind legs. The horses often lack in front, are a bit short in the neck and rise little in the front. Although the group of tested offspring includes a number of talented show-driving horses it has to be noted that the talent as show-driving horses is averagely sufficient.

Training report:

The Dries 421 offspring were on average well prepared upon arrival. They are pleasant horses both in their stall and in training. The horses have a good attitude and much willingness to work during the training. The horses made much progress during the training.

Kinship %: 17.9%

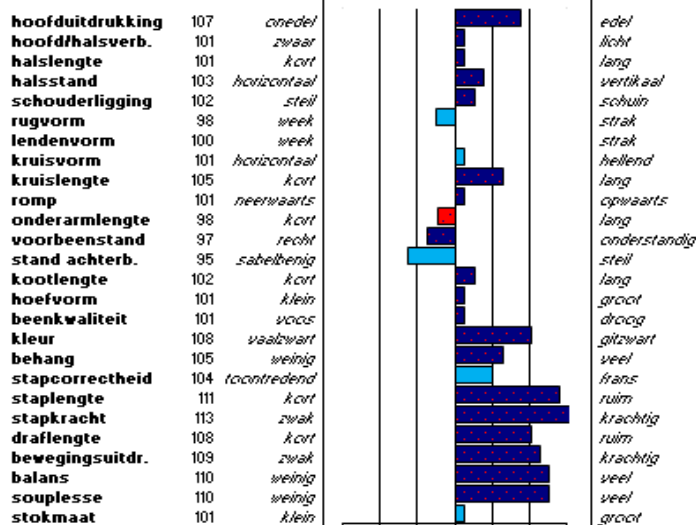
Conclusion:
